

Treasurer's report for 2020

Sandwich in Bloom's accounts for 2020 reflect the impact of 'lockdowns' and 'tierings' as a result of the coronavirus pandemic.

A modest amount of fundraising took place in the early part of the year but, from March onwards, the only funds that came into the account were from the Dover Lottery.

The only significant item of expenditure related to the filling of the barrier baskets on the Quay. It was pleasing, however, to be able to support some other initiatives in the town, by way of donations.

The bank account ended the year with just over £8,000 in the account, of which £5,000 is classified as a reserve for bridging anticipated funds and/or ensuring the survival of Sandwich in Bloom in difficult times.
